## The Bolick Foundation Frequently Asked Questions

1. As a potential new partner of The Bolick Foundation, where do I start?

We welcome new partners! You do not need an invitation to apply. Information on "How to Apply" is located on The Bolick Foundation website: www.bolickfoundation.org

Begin by setting up a login to our portal, completing and submitting the Letter of Inquiry along with financials. We will notify you if we believe our missions align. The Letter of Inquiry serves as an introduction to our organization and may be submitted at any time.

2. When is the best time to apply for funding?

The Bolick Foundation offers two funding cycles. Grants received by October 31 will be reviewed for December allocations. Grants received by April 30 will be reviewed for June allocations. Funded partners may only apply once during the fiscal year (July 1-June 30).

3. Why does The Bolick Foundation have an application process?

The Bolick Foundation was founded in 1967, and our goal is to exist in perpetuity. To support our vision, expand our outreach, and demonstrate transparency, our leadership believes initiating systems and functions will move the Foundation forward.

All faith partners wishing for funding need to make an "ask" and share the impact from any previous funding. You may apply once each fiscal year July 1-June 30. All returning partners should use the same Temelio account as your organization did previously. We do not want duplicate accounts in the system to properly register the organization's history. 4. I know of an organization that might align with The Bolick Foundation mission; may I forward your information?

Yes, please. We continue to seek new partners. Anyone wishing to submit a Letter of Inquiry may register for our portal and complete the Letter of Inquiry process.

5. Will you notify our organization whether the decision is to fund or deny the application?

Yes, we will contact the point person for each Letter of Inquiry or application submitted.

We are grateful for each organization and the work they are doing for God's Kingdom. The Bolick Foundation has limited resources and is unable to fulfill every request. If an application is denied, it is not about right and wrong, but about making choices we believe are best for our mission. The Bolick Foundation has established internal

benchmarks to assist in the review of applicants. A denied decision in no way indicates a negative assessment of your organization, project, or program.

- 6. Are there areas of focus or areas The Bolick Foundation does not fund? The Bolick Foundation is an evangelism foundation. We are not a humanitarian or relief organization; our goal is to spread the Christian gospel. We do not fund churches, church camps, capital projects, endowments, or multi-year requests currently.
  - 7. Does The Bolick Foundation fund organizations located in other countries?

The Bolick Foundation is a global foundation and supports many programs around the world. Applicants must be registered within the USA with a 501c3 organization/fiscal agent that holds a tax identification number (EIN number).

8. Is there a follow-up evaluation process if we receive funding?

It is the goal of The Bolick Foundation to have a relationship with each of our faith partners. Our desire would be periodic contact that shares the impact of your organization. These impact stories are also shared with our leadership and on our website
