

The Bolick Foundation Frequently Asked Questions

1. As a potential new partner of The Bolick Foundation, where do I start?

We welcome new partners! You do not need an invitation to apply. Information on “How to Apply” is located on The Bolick Foundation website: www.bolickfoundation.org

Begin by setting up a login to our portal within the Temelio software, then complete and submit the Letter of Inquiry along with financials. We will notify you if we believe our missions align. The Letter of Inquiry serves as an introduction to our organization and may be submitted at any time.

2. When is the best time to apply for funding?

The Bolick Foundation offers two funding cycles. Grants received by October 31 will be reviewed for December allocations. Grants received by April 30 will be reviewed for June allocations. Funded partners may only apply once during the fiscal year (July 1-June 30).

3. Why does The Bolick Foundation have an application process?

The Bolick Foundation was founded in 1967, and our goal is to exist in perpetuity. To support our vision, expand our outreach, and demonstrate transparency, our leadership believes that initiating systems and functions will move the Foundation forward.

All organizations applying for funding need to either complete a Letter of Inquiry or, for those returning partners, an application. If previously funded, partners will complete an impact report outlining results from prior funding.

All returning partners should use the same Temelio account that your organization used previously. We do not want duplicate accounts in the system to properly register the organization’s history. All organizations may apply once each fiscal year, July 1-June 30.

4. I know of an organization that might align with The Bolick Foundation's mission; may I forward your information?

Yes, please. We continue to seek new partners. Anyone wishing to submit a Letter of Inquiry may register within the Temelio portal and complete the Letter of Inquiry process.

5. Will you notify our organization whether the decision is to fund or deny the application?

Yes, we will contact the point person for each Letter of Inquiry or application submitted.

We are grateful for each organization and the work they are doing for God's Kingdom. The Bolick Foundation has limited resources and is unable to fulfill every request. If an application is denied, it is not about right and wrong, but about making choices we believe are best for our mission. The Bolick Foundation has established internal benchmarks to assist in the review of applicants. A denied decision in no way indicates a negative assessment of your organization, project, or program.

6. Are there areas of focus or areas The Bolick Foundation does not fund?

The Bolick Foundation is an evangelism foundation. We are not a humanitarian or relief organization; our goal is to spread the Christian gospel. We do not fund churches, church camps, capital projects, endowments, staff, travel, or multi-year requests currently.

7. Does The Bolick Foundation fund organizations located in other countries?

The Bolick Foundation is a global foundation that supports many programs around the world. Applicants must be registered within the USA as a 501c3 organization and hold a tax identification number (EIN number). We do not accept fiscal agents/sponsors at this time.

8. Is there a follow-up evaluation process if we receive funding?

It is the goal of The Bolick Foundation to have a relationship with each of our faith partners. An Impact Report is required for all returning partners receiving allocations. Notification to complete the Impact Report will be within the foundation's Temelio software portal. The Impact Report must be completed before applying for additional funding.
